Junior Netball Registration Terms and Conditions: SUMMER 2016/17

Junior Netball registration is open from Tuesday August 9th. Timely Registrations close on Sunday September 25th. After this point a \$25 administration fee will apply. Registrations after the completion of Round 1 are taken at the sole decision of Stadium Management.

All registrations are done online. The website is www.sportfix.net/cardinialife. It is the sole responsibility of each team contact to ensure that all players are aware of the terms and conditions of the Competition. During the registration process online you will be asked to check a box to verify that you agree to the terms and conditions of the competition. By doing so you are agreeing on behalf of your entire team and any players who join your team during that particular season. You are also agreeing to abide by the PNA by-laws, which can be found at this link www.pakenhamnetballassociation.com.au/pna-by-laws.html

Fixtures:

Fixtures are available online at www.sportfix.net/cardinialife or through the link on www.cardinialeisure.com.au. During grading, fixturing is done week by week and we try to ensure that all fixtures are posted 5 days in advance. Once grading is completed fixturing will be completed for the entire season. We do not take any time preferences. Please note that games will be scheduled as per the 'Number of Rounds' document, available at Cardinia Life reception. No time preferences are given. Please note that games can start as early as 4:20pm on a weekday and 8:10am on a weekend. Fixtures should be checked up to the day of the game. We make every endeavor to notify teams of changes however please do not rely on this.

Grading:

Grading will occur at the commencement of the season at the discretion of the PNA grading sub-committee during rounds 1 to 6. Re-grading will only occur at the PNA's discretion after 6 rounds of grading and, if required, after the 10th round of the season. Please note that grading is done on a voluntary basis. If you wish to join the grading sub-committee or if you have any other grading questions, please put them in writing to the PNA Domestic sub-committee and emailed to pakenhamnetballassoc@outlook.com

Fees:

Registration: Registration for the Summer season 2016/17 is \$62. Your registration fee DOES NOT INCLUDE insurance with Netball Victoria. Please read the Insurance section below for more details.

Team Sheet: Each week, the team sheet must be paid for by each team. The fee for the Summer season is \$62. This must be paid for prior to the starting time of your game.

Forfeits:

Should you need to forfeit your game, you will need to do so in a timely fashion. We have a 2-tiered structure for forfeits. **Notified:** A fee of \$70 applies for forfeits before the 24 hours period. This fee must be paid before the next fixtured game. **Un-notified:** A fee of \$80 for an un-notified applies. This fee must be paid before the next fixture game. For clarity, notification must be done by 6pm the day before your game to be deemed notified.

Withdrawal:

A fee of \$145 applies to any team wishing to withdraw from the season. This must be paid BEFORE the 24 hour window of your next game. Failure to do so will result in an un-notified forfeit fee on top of the withdrawal fee.

Insurance:

In order to participate in any Netball competition, you need to hold VNA Insurance. If you are unsure whether you hold a VNA Insurance you can attempt to log in via the link on this website www.pakenhamnetballassociation.com.au. If you are having issues with this or you think that you might not have a valid email address please email pakenhamnetballassoc@outlook.com for assistance. Please note that your insurance expires on December 31st, 2016. You will need to renew your Insurance by the first game in 2017. Please also note your insurance is fully transferable, meaning you only need to purchase insurance ONCE per calendar year. This insurance covers you for all Netball Victoria sanctioned competitions.

Any player who is injured during the course of the game should seek 1st Aid from the Centre.

We recommend that all players hold their own personal insurance in addition to VNA Insurance.

Finals Eligibility:

All players must play a total of six (6) games to qualify for all finals games.

Please note: PNA will not make any allowances towards this rule. Any team that plays a player that has not qualified for finals will result in a forfeit. To ensure player eligibility is confirmed - the team sheets must be filled in thoroughly each game.

TO ADD A NEW PLAYER AFTER REGISTRATION, ALL DETAILS (Full Name, Address, Date of Birth, Phone Number and email) MUST BE ADDED TO THE REVERSE OF THE TEAMSHEET, failure to correctly register a player will result in a technical forfeit for the team. If a player is to be removed from the team, please put the word "remove" next to their name.

Scoring Duties:

Each team must supply a competent scorer for each game (12 years and over).

Age Cut Off:

Any child must be under the age of the division they intend to play in by the 31st December 2016. For example, you cannot play in 15 & Under, if you will turn 16 before the 31st December. All junior players must supply Proof of Age document with the registration form. This is compulsory for all players. This may be checked at random during the season.

Working with Children Check (WWC):

As of June 2009 it is a requirement that all coaches and team managers over the age of 18 obtain a current Working with Children Check.

Uniform Rules:

It is the responsibility of all teams to ensure they have correct uniforms. Teams have a 3 week window from their first scheduled game to have matching uniforms. Penalties will apply to teams who do not abide by these rules. Uniform rules are as follows:

- Female players are given the option to wear shorts. If one or more players wear shorts, then ALL players must wear shorts. NO EXCEPTIONS (Shorts worn must be suitable for sport with no pockets or buckles.)
- All skirts or shorts must consist of the same colour and design.

Other conditions:

You should familiarize yourself with all codes of conduct relating to Netball. These can be found through the Netball Victoria website and the PNA website. You should also be aware of the Terms and Conditions of entry into the Cardinia Life facility. These are clearly posted at the reception area of the facility.
